These are options that everyone at the LSE will have access to. Here you can manage your account details.


#### **Prospective Student**

## 2 ACCOUNT MANAGEMENT

#### 2.1 Email address

Your email address also acts as the username for your log in. If you wish to change this email address then you can access this by clicking on "Account Management" followed by "Change Username"



You will be expected to enter your password to be able to make the changes.

#### 3.1.1 Changing addresses

If the system does not recognise your postcode/zip code, then please contact the support team to have the postcode updated on the system. This can happen when a postcode is new, for example in new developments.



## 4 GRADUATE APPLICATION TRACKER

#### 4.1 Application tracker

You are able to check on the status of your application using the Graduate Application Tracker. This tracker also allows you to see which documents you still need to submit and at what stage your application is at in the admissions process.

**Note:** You are unable to make any changes to your application once it has been submitted. If there is an error you must contact the Graduate Admissions department.



#### 4.2 First preference/Second preference

If you applied for two courses and you would like to check on the status of your second preference then you should click on the arrow next to "1<sup>st</sup>" to be able to switch between preferences. Your second preference will not be processed until you have either been made an offer or rejected from your first choice course.



#### 4.3 Documentation

This section details the additional documentation that has been received and processed with your application.

If you have submitted documentation you must wait for it to first be processed before it will appear on the tracker. If it does not appear, you can click on the link to get an update on how long it is taking for documents to be processed.

#### 4.4 Contacting the Graduate Admissions department



#### 5.1 Financial Undertaking Form

To access this form, click on the "Financial Undertaking Form" tab in the left menu.




